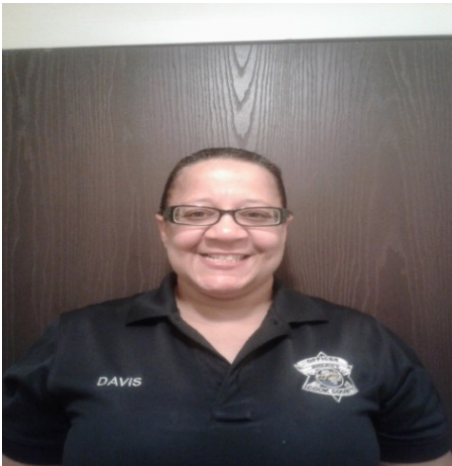


2018 COOK COUNTY EMPLOYEE CANDIDATE STATEMENT
